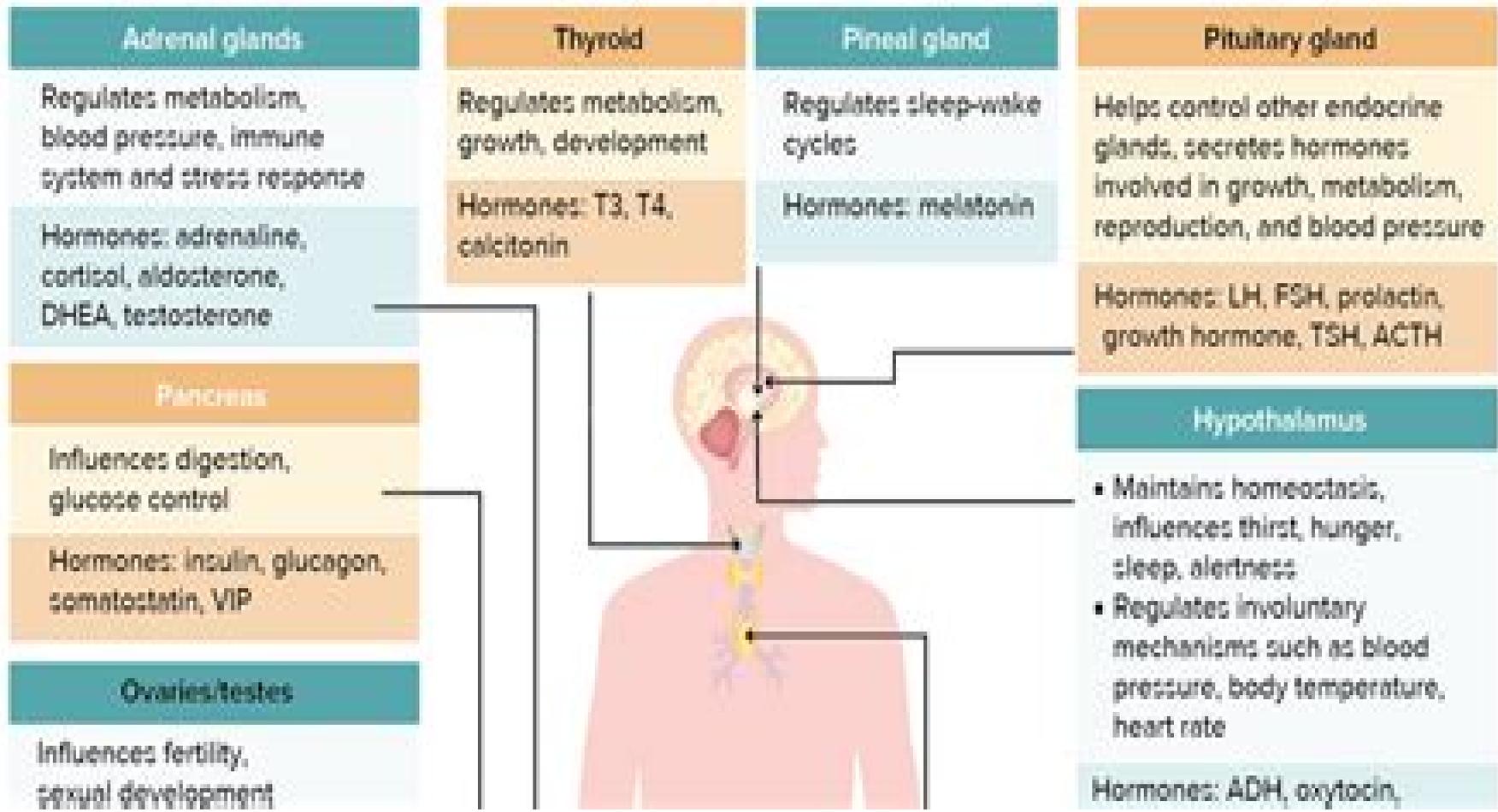


ENDOCRINE SYSTEM
