Chapter One:

- Anatomy- the study of the structure of the human body and its parts
 - Physiology- the study of the function of the human body and its parts
 - Structure/Function = Anatomy/Physiology
 - The structure of organs and parts determine the function
 - If a structure changes, its function might also; directly dependent
- EX: Hemoglobin molecules
- Structure = flat, concave, circular
 - This allows for oxygen to be close to the surface of a cell, so it can pass through the blood stream in and away from the heart
 - Function = to carry oxygen
 - Function is to carry oxygen so the flat/circular structure makes sense
- *If the structure is mutated, sickle-cell anemia results***
- function is directly affected b/c of a change in structure
- Levels of Structural Organization
 - Subatomic Particles: protons, neutrons, electrons that make up cells
 - Atom: tiny particles that make up chemicals EX: hydrogen, carbon
 - Molecule: particles consisting of atoms EX: water, glucose
 - Macromolecule: large particles consisting of molecules EX: DNA, protein
 - Organelle: functional part of a cell EX: mitochondria, lysosome
 - Cell: basic unit of structure and function EX: muscle, nerve, or blood cell
 - Tissue: layer or mass of cells with specific function EX: adipose tissue
 - Organ: group of different tissues with a function EX: heart, kidney, liver
 - Organ System: group of organs w/ common function EX: digestive system
 - Organism: composed of organ systems interacting EX: human
- *To know what is going on w/ the body as a whole, you must know how each part is functioning and interacting!***
- Organ Systems
 - Integumentary: protection, thermoregulation, sensory reception, vitamin D production
 - Skeletal: framework, protection, attachment site, storage of inorganic salts, support and movement, produce blood cells (bone marrow)
 - Muscular: movement, body heat, maintain posture
 - Nervous: control center, detects changes in body and reacts if needed using nerve impulses
 - Endocrine: integration and coordination of organ function through hormone impulses
