

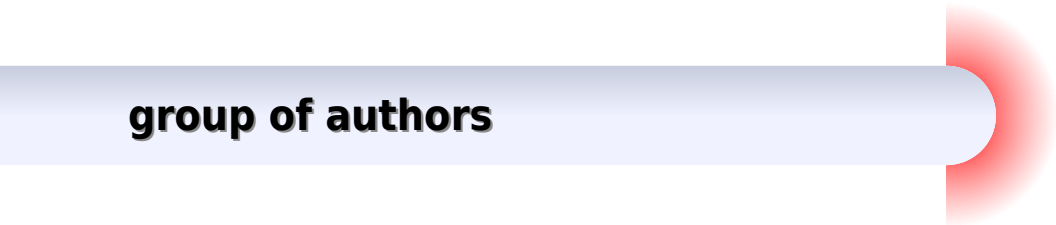

The book is divided into four parts: Software Engineering, A Programming Language Mechanisms and Type Systems, B Theory, C and Language Design, and Programming Methodology, D.
