INTERNET VOTING FOR PUBLIC OFFICIALS

People have voted by mail for years to elect officers of corporations and other organizations. More recently, they have begun casting these votes via the Internet. A logical next step, many say, is allowing ordinary citizens to vote for public officials via the Internet.

Internet voting has played a role in several recent U.S. presidential elections. The history-making 2000 elec-

tions included approximately 250 selected U.S. military personnel stationed overseas. Almost 50% of the votes in the Arizona Democratic Party's March 2000 binding presidential primary were cast via the Internet. In the Alaska Republican Party's January 2000 presidential straw poll, 35 people voted via the Internet. And in 1996, the Reform Party offered its members the option of voting for its presidential candidate by casting their ballots online, by mail, by phone, or in person.
