Exercise 1

1. **Anticipate and Answer Users' Queries:** the concept idea stores summary of trips. It displays messages like "distance covered, score, points and redeemed points."
2. **In-App Search:** the user can search for the trips done in past one week. The user just need to enter the date they took the trip and all the information about the trip will come up e.g. current location and destination, distance in km, scores and points earned, any distraction and speeding.
3. **Single Trail Learning Experience:** the app is very simple to learn in fact the user can switch between menus just by swiping left. The user can also select theme specific to their choice and the theme automatically changes in day and night. In addition, the app also has user guide in form of vides that better helps users navigate through the app.
